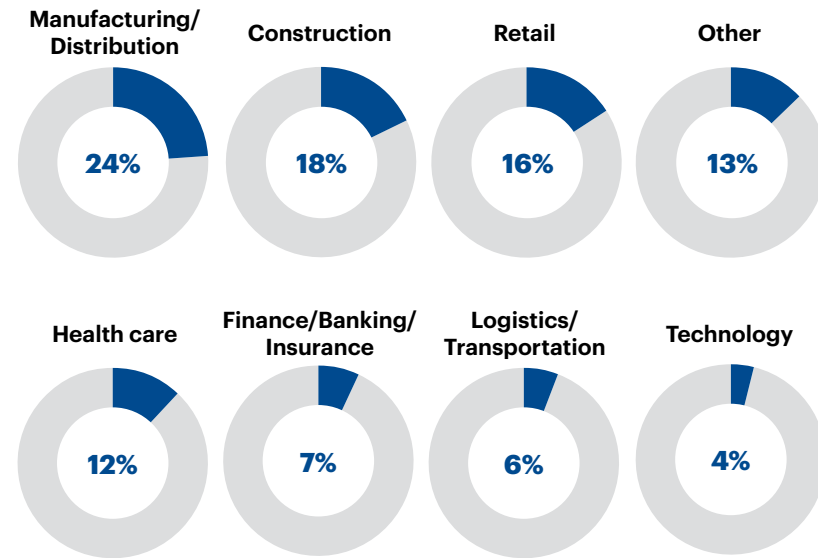


BUILT FOR SPEED

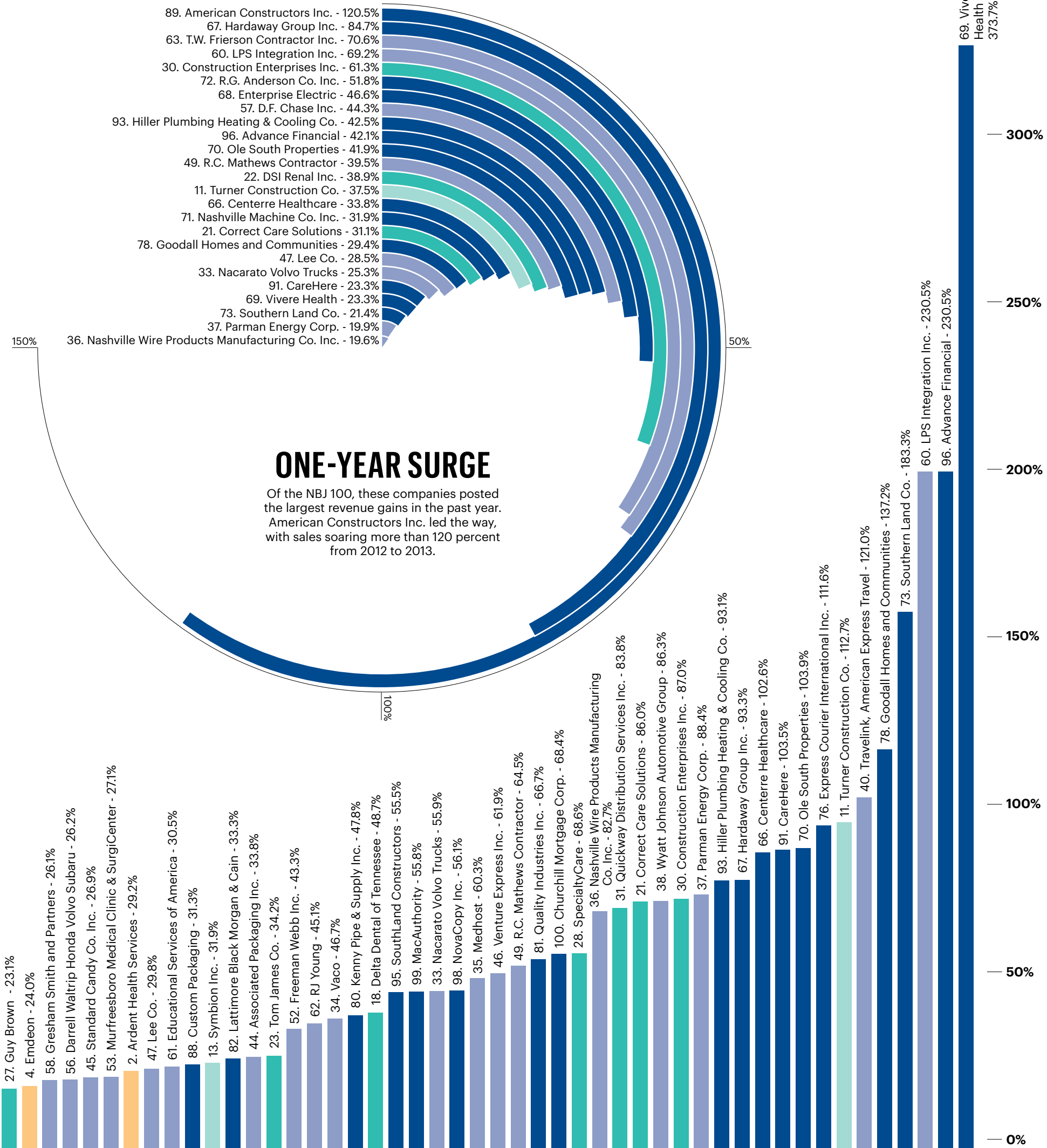
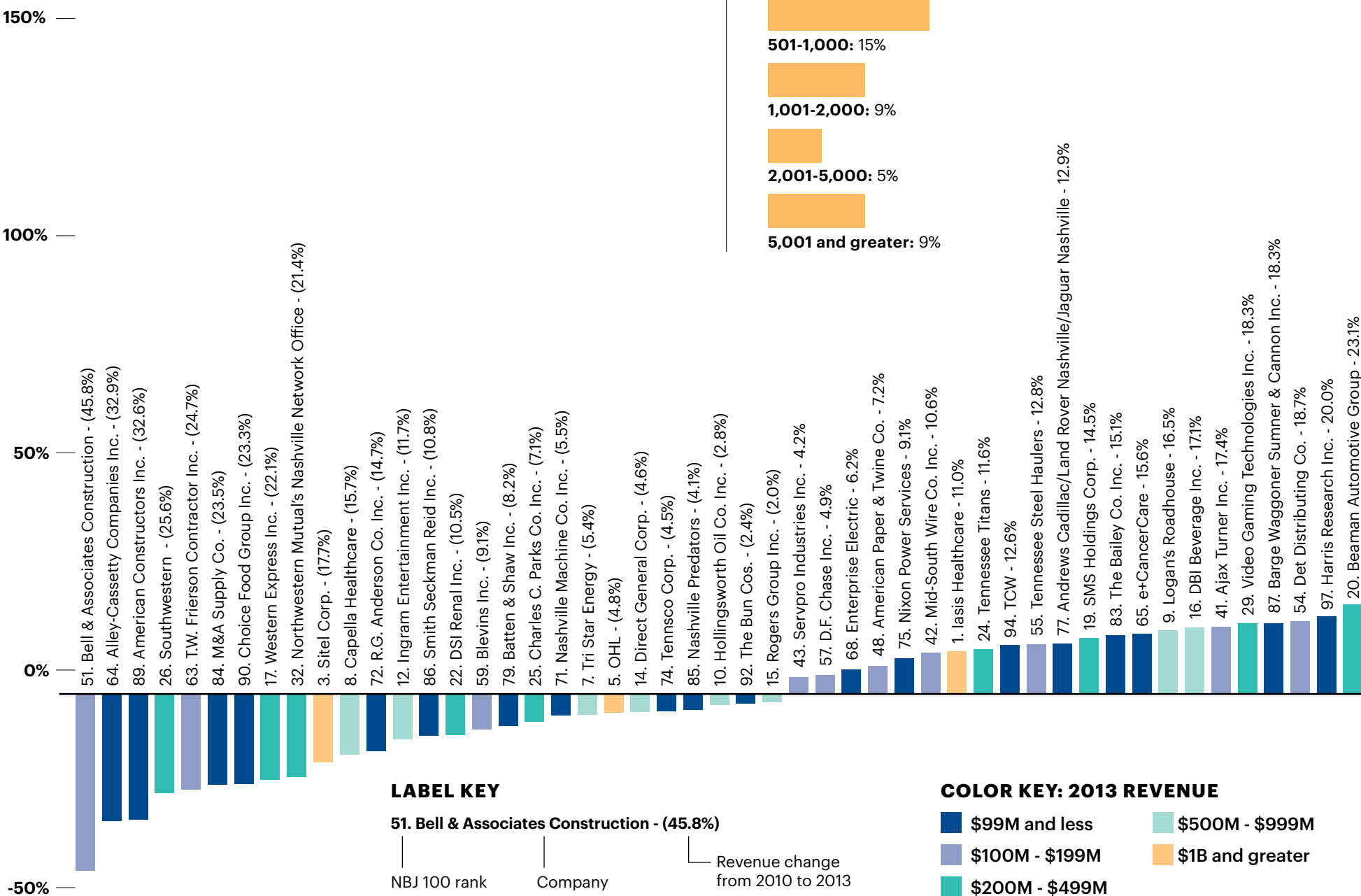
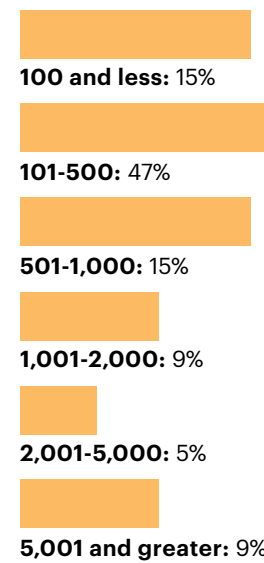
DIVERSE ECONOMY

THE SWEET SPOT

Nearly half of the companies on the NBJ 100 have between 101 to 500 employees, while 77 percent of them have fewer than 1,000 employees. Here's the breakdown of the largest private companies by employee size.
