

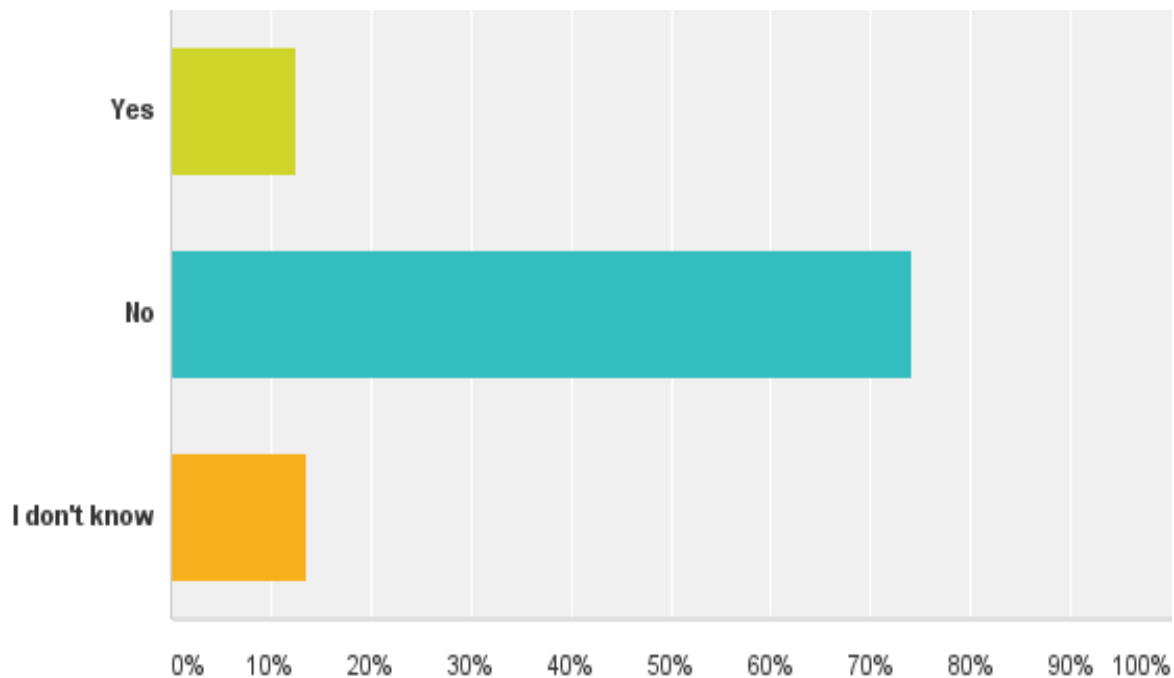

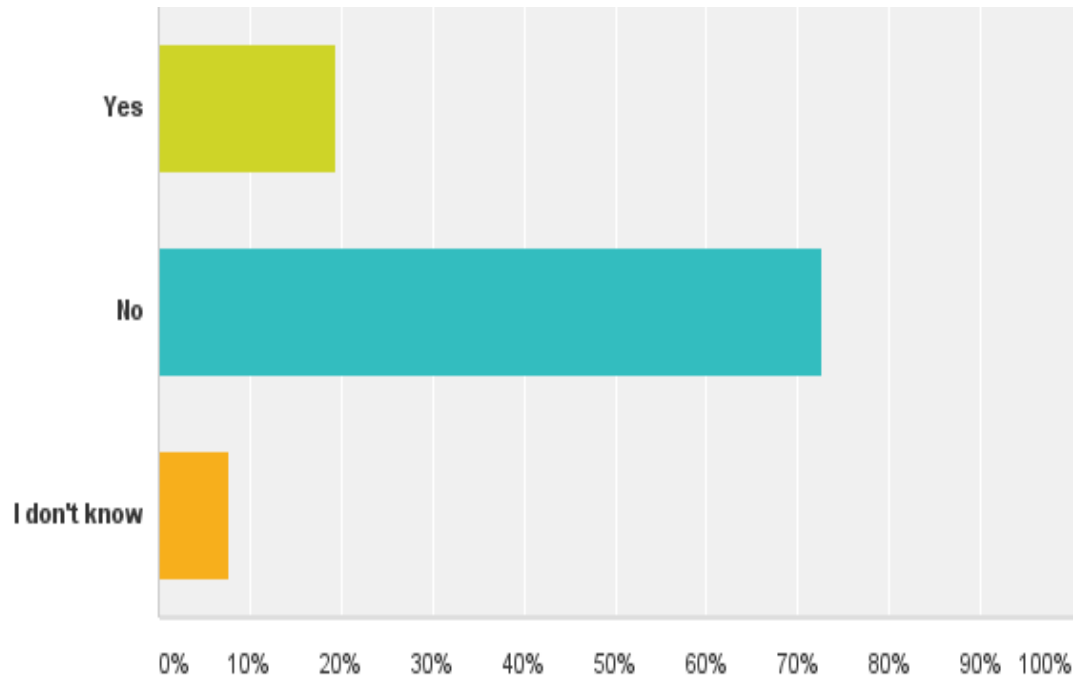

Q1: Do you feel prepared to deal with a potential Ebola outbreak or patient?



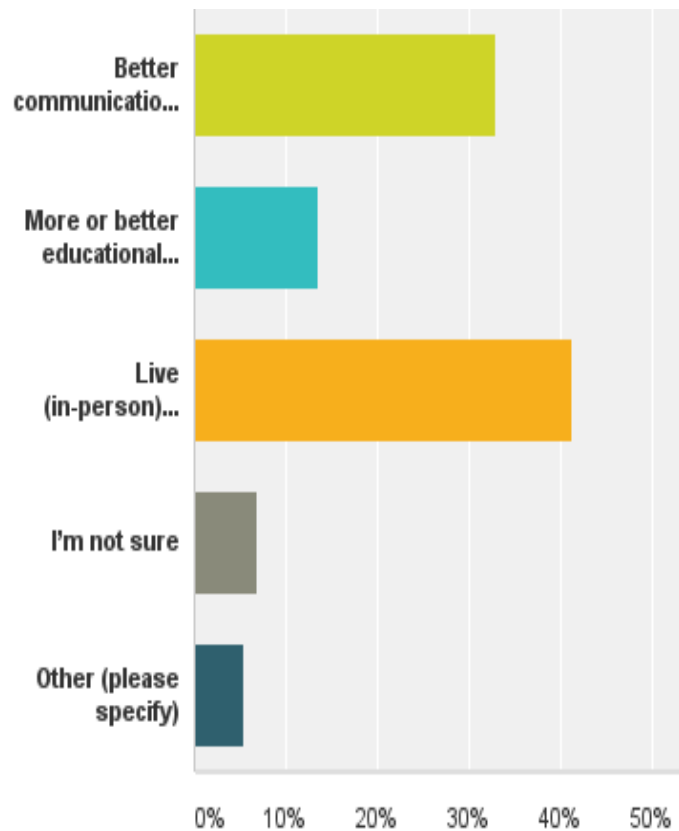

Q2: Has your hospital or healthcare facility addressed the issue or provided training to you and other nurses?



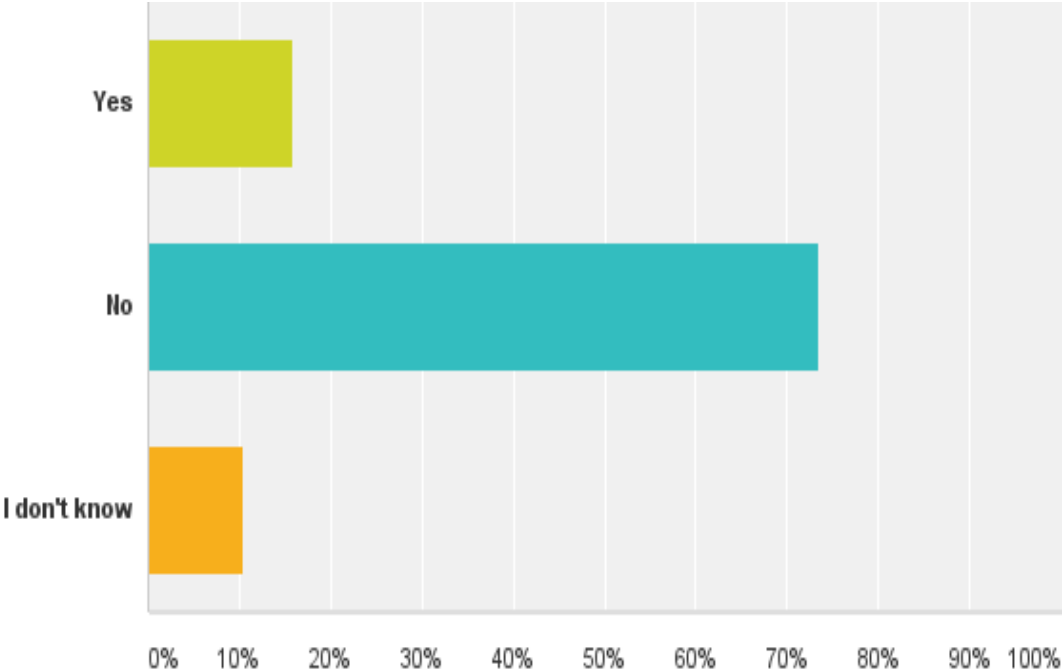

Q3: What would be the most helpful to you in dealing with the threat or reality of Ebola?



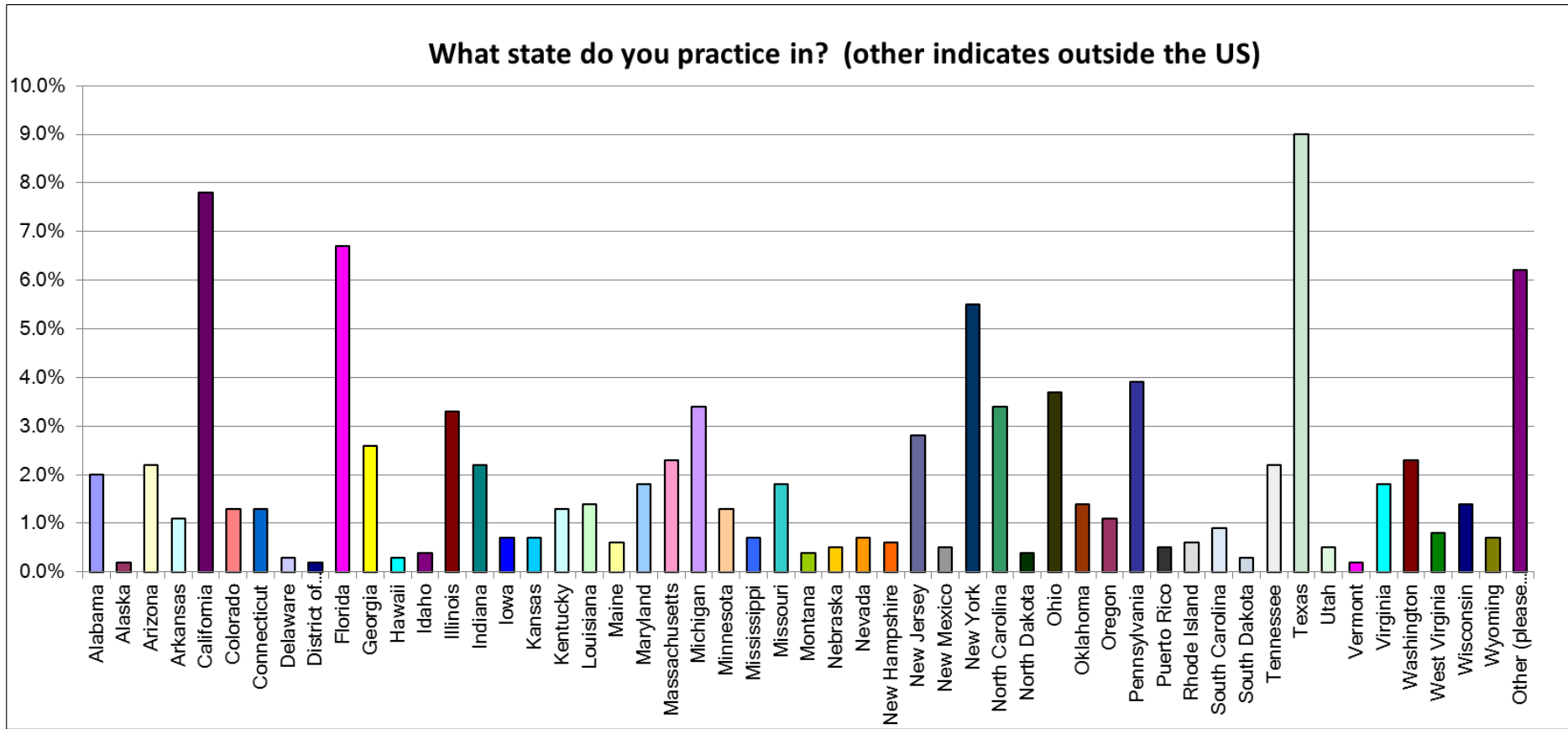

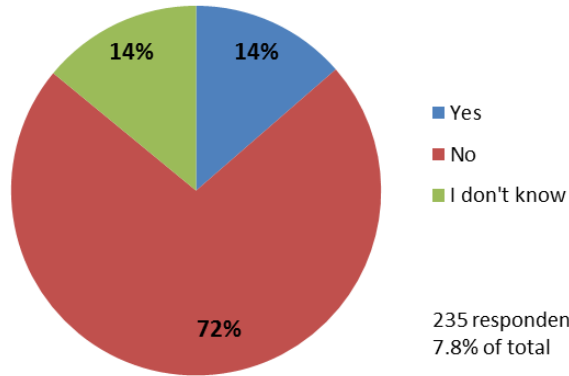
Q5: What state do you practice in? (please choose other at bottom of list if outside the US)



State by State Comparison

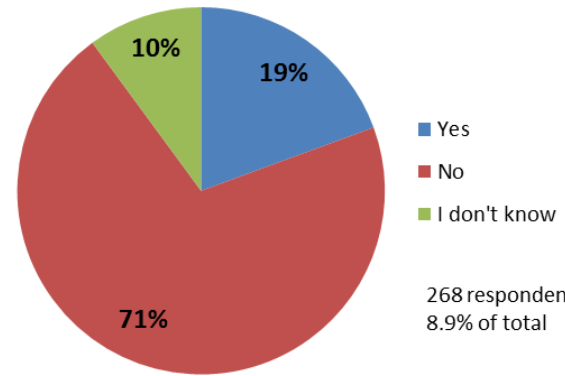
