### BANKRUPTCY AUCTION OF WORKING INTERESTS IN 109 PRODUCING GAS WELLS IN THE PICEANCE BASIN, GARFIELD COUNTY, CO

The bankruptcy trustee of Savage Resources, LLC will hold an auction sale of substantially all of Savage Resources' assets, including the working interests in approximately 109 natural gas wells and lease rights to additional acreage.
