

Deborah Gash

Senior Vice President and Chief Digital Officer Saint Luke's Health System

Leadership Award recipient on advanced health care technology

Deborah Gash joined Saint Luke's Hospital in Kansas City in 1992 to manage physician services for Saint Luke's Medical Group and serve as a project manager and director of application development in information services. At the time, the public did not have internet access; that would come the following year. The use of electronic medical records (EMR) wasn't on anyone's radar.

Thirty-one years later, Gash still provides her expertise to Saint Luke's Health System (SLHS), now as the network's senior vice president and chief digital officer, a role she's held since 2017. Saint Luke's has since expanded to a network of 14 hospitals and campuses across the Kansas City region, along with home care and hospice services, a senior living community and more than 100 primary care and specialty offices treating patients in 65 specialty services. Over the last three decades, Gash has shaped the digital experience at Saint Luke's by developing and implementing critical IT strategies, providing technology support, guiding cost-effective clinical and business solutions and fostering a digital culture.

"The mission to serve the community provides personal and professional fulfillment," said Gash.

For the impact she has had over the course of her career, Gash has been selected as the Leadership Award recipient as part of the 2023 Kansas City ORBIE Awards. The program honors current or former chief information officers who have a proven track record of successful technology leadership, made significant contributions to the Kansas City technology

and business community and inspired others through their personal, professional and civic contributions.

Enhancing the patient and physician experience

A defining moment of Gash's career was the selection and implementation of Epic Systems Corp. as the health system's electronic medical records software. Epic is the maker of the patient portal, MyChart. "The selection of Epic set the stage to transform Saint Luke's Health System into a digital health system," Gash said. That choice and the challenging multi-year effort elevated Gash's role in the organization.

"The advanced digital front door has offered many conveniences to patients," said Gash. Through SLHS's EMR, patients can use a desktop portal or mobile app to find the necessary care; interact with their care team in a variety of ways, including through virtual visits; schedule and check in for appointments; access lab and test results; request prescription refills; and pay bills through various digital methods.

Under Gash's leadership, SLHS has been able to expand telehealth care, providing expanded, improved access to patients. SLHS also developed home-based care models, such as Saint Luke's Hospital In Your Home, the area's first program to offer high-quality, hands-on care through an around-the-clock, virtual platform. Through this program, patients with serious conditions, such as congestive heart failure, pneumonia, gastroenteritis or COPD, who would normally require treatment in an inpatient hospital setting

may be able to be treated in the comfort of their own home if they meet a certain set of criteria.

Gash's contributions to boost the hospital system's technologies have also made a smoother experience for doctors and the clinical staff. "Remote work and automation help make them more efficient and create new work experiences," said Gash.

Developing people

The effectiveness of Gash's leadership at SLHS extends beyond the selection of technologies to the impact she has on people she leads. "One of the key aspects of my job is to lead, motivate and develop IT talent so the organization's goals are met. It's key for me to collaborate with others and innovate to accomplish the organization's strategy."

An active leader in the local IT community, Gash helped bring the TechLX (Technology Leadership Experience) to Kansas City. TechLX provides in-depth learning opportunities for mid-level technology leaders. She's also served on the board of the Healthcare Information and Management Systems Society (HIMSS), another organization that focuses on providing career development to health IT professionals. "I've enjoyed encouraging the development of technology professionals in Kansas City," said Gash.

Of her current organization, Gash said," Saint Luke's has provided me with opportunities to learn and develop. I've been challenged and felt valued for my contributions."

SUCCESS STORY

Company relied on a central datacenter that was out of space, unable to handle the scale of where the company was going. The datacenter bandwidth was maxed out and could not support employees working remotely, to get more, required an expensive 3/4 mile new conduit/fiber installation and a year of construction. We decided to move all workloads on 12/7/2019. The company went full remote on 3/16/2020; our employees could work from their homes, they were there for our clients, our business experienced unprecedented growth due in part because the systems were available for them to take care of our clients.

He is currently a CTO at Hallmark, transforming technology to develop products relevant to the next-generation consumers, and establishing lean development practices and teams for the organization to transform the delivery model with a focus on experimentation and customer testing that will bring a huge impact on the ROI for projects.

SUCCESS STORY

Chai led Walmart's first Hack Day, which laid the foundation for innovative thinking. Before joining Hallmark, Chai was a CTO at Tailored Brands where he led the omnichannel strategy to provide a seamless experience across the channels to the customers. Prior to that, he led the effort to build the eCommerce platform for Levis and built the Digital team ground up. Currently working on establishing the lean development practices and teams for the organization to transform the delivery model with a focus on experimentation and customer testing that will bring a huge impact to the ROI for projects.

The Textron Aviation Information Technology team received its highest Gartner end-user support survey feedback score in 2020, further underscoring the IT team's attention to detail throughout the process and solidifying Textron Aviation's stance as a world-class manufacturing company.



Kevin Hunt Spirit Aerosystems



Kevin Hunt was named Vice President and CIO in April of 2020. He joined Spirit in 2007, as an IT Security Manager, from the United States Air Force after 12 years as a Communications Officer. Kevin has held numerous positions at Spirit in IT, Security, Fabrication, Program Management, Manufacturing, Operations and Supply Chain. He earned his bachelor's degree in computer science from California State University at Fullerton and has an MBA from Webster University.

SUCCESS STORY

During my time leading the Spirit IT team we have had a significant impact on the business. We have delivered automated manufacturing technology to the heart of Spirit's Manufacturing environment which has increased efficiencies by 15% and reduced overall work-in-process by more than 20%. Additionally, we were able to carve-out the systems of a major acquisition and bring them onto the Spirit network in a 12-month timeframe saving Spirit over \$9M in transition technical services and mitigating over \$40M in cost. Additionally, we've been able to reduce our technical debt by more than \$5M dollars by our cloud transition.


