Bill VanCuren is the president of BVC Advisors. As a global business executive and board member, he leads transformations for growth through a balance of technology and business solutions, from private to publicly traded, from mid-size to multibillion-dollar corporations. VanCuren is an insightful business leader who leads teams through uncertain times, drives execution, and is always at the confluence of human factors and technology introduction.

Coaching skills and building diverse teams

VanCuren's coaching skills and experience includes building diverse teams with culture that respects individuals while achieving aggressive corporate goals for profit and expense discipline. He is also a mentor to other CIOs and technology professionals in Atlanta as well as across the U.S. He excels at both one-on-one coaching and group sessions based upon experiential learning and adaptive real world case studies. VanCuren uses situational leadership techniques to demonstrate how to apply the best style to the situation.

Shelia Anderson joined Aflac in July 2022 as Senior Vice President, Chief Information Officer where she is responsible for overseeing Aflac's Digital Services division and driving the technology strategy in support of the company's Corporate, Global Investments, Individual, Group VB, Premier Life Absence and Disability, and Aflac Benefits Solutions (Dental and Vision). Anderson received her BS in Computer Science from Louisiana Tech University and her MS in Engineering Management from Southern Methodist University.

SUCCESS STORY

Aflac previously operated with a decentralized IT model, leading to duplicated capabilities, fragmented experiences, operational inefficiencies, and quality inconsistencies. To address this, we centralized technology into a unified organization by merging five entities, increasing employee footprint, while maintaining zero business impact. This consolidation resulted in cost reductions and allowed us to reinvest in modernization without employee reductions. We focused on engineering excellence, architectural discipline, and a robust data and AI strategy, exemplified by the award-winning MyAflac system, which automated 54% of claims. Our efforts also improved our Run/Grow/Transform metrics from 73/23/4 to 64/20/16.

We are a much more secure & data driven company now than we were a year ago.

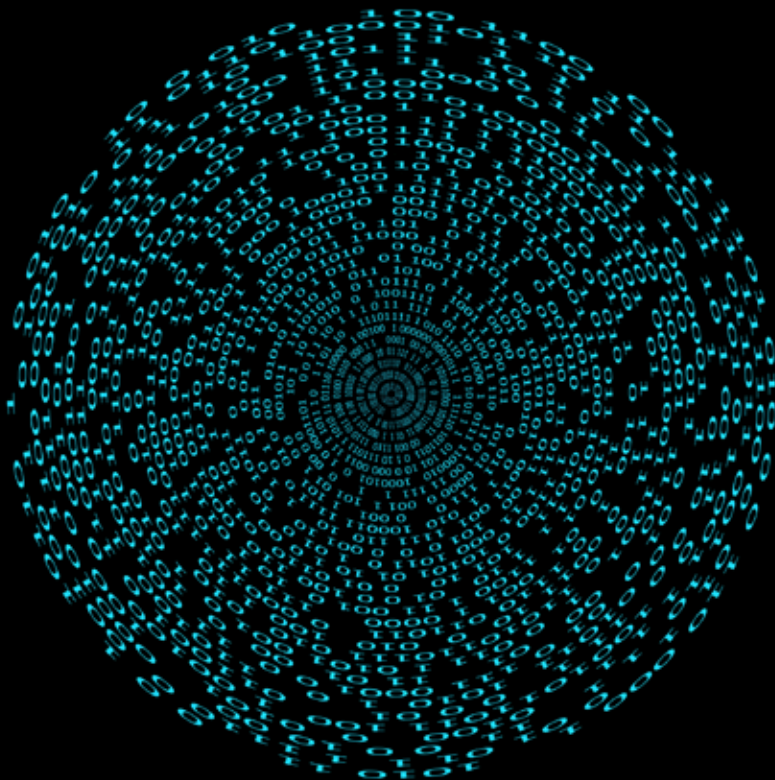
